COST **approx. \$1500**

- \$450 per participant fee
- \$675 flight + luggage + trip ins.
- \$100 van rental fee per participant
- \$25 gratuity for cleaning & lodging
- \$60 meals provided by church
- \$60 groceries to make group meals
- \$60 restaurant meals
- Other personal expenses
- Offering for worship

MEALS

Groups prepare the majority of meals throughout the week. One to two meals are provided as part of the experience. There are additional opportunities for local restaurant dining. Kitchen facilities are available for use.

HOUSING

Groups stay in two dorm-style rooms complete with bunks, shower facilities, towels and linens. Free wi-fi available.

TRANSPORTATION

Cristo Rey provides transportation while in El Paso, including trips to and from the airport.

LANGUAGE

Spanish language skills are helpful, but not necessary. Translators are provided.

U.S. PASSPORT

Participants must bring a valid US Passport for reentry into the USA from Mexico.
